STATEMENT OF THE CASE

On March 8, 2018, OXY presented a landperson, a geologist and nine exhibits in support of the initial application in Case No. 16013 seeking an order (1) creating a 160-acre non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 E/2 of Section 13, Township 24 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this acreage. Under its initial application, OXY proposed to dedicate the above-referenced spacing and proration unit as the project area for its proposed Nimitz MDP1

"13" Federal Com No. 1H Well, which was to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) to a standard bottom hole location in SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 13.

Since the March 8th hearing, OXY has decided to not drill the proposed Nimitz MDP1 "13" Federal Com No. 1H Well. Instead, OXT intends to dedicate the proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit to its proposed Nimitz MDP1 "13" Federal Com No. 2H Well. This replacement well will be drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 12 to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 13, Township 24 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The completed interval for this well will remain within the 330-foot standard offset required by the Statewide Rules set forth in 19.15.15 NMAC.
