STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Mewbourne's application seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation in a standard 240-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2 W/2 of Section 26 and the W/2 SW/4 of Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 34 East in Lea County, New Mexico. The horizontal spacing unit will be dedicated to Mewbourne's proposed Inland 26/23 B2ML State Com #1H and Inland 26/23 B3ML State Com #2H wells. Both wells will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit M in Section 26 to a last take point in Unit L in Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 34 East. The completed intervals for the wells will comply with the Division's setback requirements.
