STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Mewbourne's application seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Third Bone Spring Sand interval of the Bone Spring formation in a 240-acre standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2 S/2 of Section 11 and the S/2 SW/4 of Section 12, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., in Eddy County.

Mewbourne proposes to dedicate the horizontal spacing unit to the Sapphire 11/12 B3MN State Com #2H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit M in Section 11 to a last take point in Unit N in Section 12, Township 19 South, Range 29 East. Mewbourne will drill the well to a depth sufficient to test the Third Bone Spring Sand interval of the Bone Spring formation. The completed interval for the well will be orthodox.
