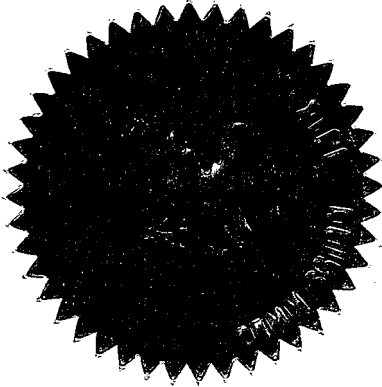

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

THIS MATTER comes before the Oil Conservation Commission (the "Commission") on the motion of Marathon Oil Permian, LLC ("Marathon") to dismiss the above listed cases before the Commission and to lift a stay. Marathon filed its Application for Hearing De Novo on January 22, 2019, and the orders in these cases were stayed by the Director of the Oil Conservation Division on February 1, 2019. No party opposes this motion.

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission grants the motion and dismisses Case Nos. 16234, 16235, 16313, 16386, 16387, and 16388, and lifts the stay of Division Order Nos. R-20312, R-20295, R-20296, R-20313, R-20314, and R-20515.
