### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Mewbourne's application seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation in a 398.54-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 N/2 of Section 3, the N/2 N/2 of Section 4, and the N/2 NE/4 of Section 5, Township 20 South, Range 30 East in Eddy County, New Mexico.

Mewbourne proposes to dedicate the horizontal spacing unit to the Caballo Loco 5/3 B2BA Fed Com #3H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit B in Section 5 to a bottom hole location in Unit A in Section 3, Township 20 South, Range 30 East. The completed interval for the well will be orthodox.
