NOW, on this 27<sup>th</sup> day of February 2020, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendation of the Examiner.

#### FINDS THAT:

The information submitted though affidavit is inaccurate in the following areas:

Exhibit A was missing and was requested on January 24, 2020 and received February 24, 2020

The C-102 does not match the Exhibit A or the APD regarding the well name and bottom hole location.

The C-102 does not match the Exhibit A regarding the Spacing Unit Size.

The AFE reflects a cost estimate for a measured depth of 18,825 feet where the APD has a proposed depth of 11,975 feet.

The APD is intended for a  $2^{nd}$  Bone Spring Sand where Exhibit A and in hearing it was stated that these wells are for  $3^{rd}$  Bone Spring Testing.

# IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

This case is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
