This case came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on August 8, 2019 at Santa Fe, New Mexico before Examiner Leonard R. Lowe.

NOW, on this 27<sup>th</sup> day of February 2020, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendation of the Examiner,

**FINDS THAT:**

The information submitted though affidavit is inaccurate in the following areas:

Exhibit A was missing and was requested on January 24, 2020 and received February 24, 2020

The C-102 does not match the Exhibit A or the APD regarding the well name and bottom hole location.

The C-102 does not match the Exhibit A regarding the Spacing Unit Size.

The AFE reflects a cost estimate for a measured depth of 18,943 feet where the APD has a proposed depth of 11,920 feet.

The APD is intended for a 2<sup>nd</sup> Bone Spring Sand where Exhibit A and in hearing it was stated that these wells are for 3<sup>rd</sup> Bone Spring Testing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

This case is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
