Application of Hudson Oil Company of Texas, William A. Hudson and Edward R. Hudson for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the base of the San Andres formation through the base of the Morrow formation in the following described acreage in Section 12, Township 17 South, Range 31 East: the N/2 to form a standard 320-acre spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Undesignated Fren–Morrow Gas Pool; the NW/4 to form a standard spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent and the NW/4 NW/4 to form a standard spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent and the NW/4 NW/4 to form a standard spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Undesignated East Fren-Paddock Pool. Said units are to be dedicated to its Francotte Federal Well No. 1 to be drilled 660 feet from the North and West lines of said Section 12 to an approximate depth of 12,500 feet. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Hudson Oil Company of Texas as operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 3 miles east northeast of Maljamar, New Mexico.
