Applicant will offer evidence that the condition of the well(s) is such that plugging thereof is necessary for the prevention of waste, protection of correlative rights and protection of the environment, and that, in event of the operator's failure to plug same, the Division should be authorized to plug said well(s), to forfeit any financial assurance furnished by operator, and to seek reimbursement from operator for any excess of plugging costs incurred by the Division over and above the amount realized from forfeiture of such financial assurance. Also to be considered will be the propriety of the plugging procedure proposed by the Division staff.
