WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 9:00 a.m.:

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CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay, let's go ahead and go on the record. Let the record reflect that this is the Thursday, July 13th, 2006, meeting of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. Let the record also reflect that all three Commissioners are present, those Commissioners being Jami Bailey, the designee of Patrick H. Lyons, the Land Commissioner; Mr. William Olson; and myself, Mr. Mark Fesmire.

The first order of business before the Commission today is to notice that it is 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 13th, and the minutes of the June 15th, 2006, Commission meeting need to be adopted.

Have the Commissioners had a chance to review the minutes as presented by the Commission secretary?

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move we adopt them.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Is there a second?

COMMISSIONER OLSON:

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Let the record reflect that the Commission will adopt the minutes and that the Chairman will sign the minutes and convey it to the Commission secretary.

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CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: That having been done, the next case before the Commission is the consolidated cases, Case Number 13,367, the de novo Application of Bass Enterprises Production Company for an order authorizing the drilling of a well in the potash area, Eddy County, New Mexico; Case Number 13,368, the de novo Application of Devon Energy Company, LP, for an order authorizing the drilling of a well in the potash area in Eddy County, New Mexico; and Case Number 13,372, the de novo Application of Devon Energy Production Company for approval of an unorthodox well location and authorization to drill a well in the potash area in Eddy County, New Mexico.

Let the record reflect that the Commission counsel today is Cheryl Bada. Ms. Bada, would you bring us up to speed on where we are procedurally in these cases?

MS. BADA: I drafted two orders, one for Bass's

Application and the other for Devon's two Applications, and
the orders deny the Applications as determined by the

Commission during executive session in this last week.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay, have the Commissioners had a chance to review these two orders?

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I will sign it.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Commissioner Olson, have you had a chance to review the orders?

COMMISSIONER OLSON: Yes, I've also reviewed them, and they reflect our deliberations, I believe.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay, let the record that the two orders presented by counsel and the Commission secretary today accurately reflect the Commission's decision in these three cases. Again, there are two orders, one in case Number 13,367 and the other one in Cases Number 13,368 and 13,372.

The Chair would entertain a motion to sign these orders as presented?

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I move we sign them as presented.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Is there a second?

COMMISSIONER OLSON: Second.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: All those in favor?

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye.

Let the record reflect that this case has been continued from the April 20th, 2006, Commission meeting, and will be continued to the August 10th, 2006, Commission meeting.
