WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 9:05 a.m.: 2 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next cause before the 3 Commission is Case Number 13,586, the Application of the 4 New Mexico Oil Division for repeal of existing Rules 709, 5 710, 711 concerning surface waste management and the 6 adoption of new rules governing surface waste management. 7 This case has been continued to the April 20th, 8 2006, Commission meeting at the request -- at the motion, I 9 believe, of an industry committee consisting of 17 10 operators in the state. That motion for continuance has 11 been adopted, and this case will be continued to the April 12 13 20th, 2006, Commission meeting. 14 15 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next cause before the 16 Commission is Case Number 13,274, the Application of Arch 17 Petroleum, Inc., for approval of two nonstandard gas 18 spacing and proration units in the Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea 19 20 County, New Mexico. I believe at the request of the Applicant this 21 22 case has been committed -- "committed" -- continued, from 23 the February 9th docket to the April 20th, 2006, Commission 24 docket. 25

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The next cause before the 1 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: 2 Commission is Case Number 13,367, the Application of Bass Enterprises Production Company for an order authorizing the 3 drilling of a well in the potash area in Eddy County, New 4 Mexico. 5 There's a related case, Case Number 13,368, the 6 Application of Devon Energy Production Company, LP, for an 7 order authorizing the drilling of a well in the potash area 8 in Eddy County, New Mexico. 9 These cases will be continued to a special 10 meeting. 11 At this time, Mr. Carr, who is -- I guess will 12 13 make his appearance in both cases? MR. CARR: Actually, Mr. Chairman, in all three 14 15 cases. The last case is also a related case seeking well 16 location in the potash area. CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay, that's Case Number 17 13,372? And you're asking that these cases be specially 18 19 set together --20 Yes, sir. MR. CARR: 21 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: -- at a special meeting? 22 MR. CARR: Yes, sir. They involve a common 23 issue, and although they're separate cases and involve separate well locations, the issues are virtually identical 24 25 in each of the cases.

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The cases were heard over a year ago. And after 1 the order was entered Mosaic Potash, who had opposed the 2 case, sought hearing de novo. 3 They will take a -- should take a full day to 4 hear, but should not go more than that. 5 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: A full day for all three of 6 them? 7 MR. CARR: For all three of them. 8 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: 9 Okay. MR. CARR: And we've asked for a special hearing 10 date because of that, because every regular date has other 11 things on it. 12 I have talked with Charles High, the attorney 13 from Mosaic -- I talked with him several weeks ago and 14 again yesterday afternoon -- and he has recommended three 15 dates that he could be available to hear these. He has two 16 cases going in federal court the next two months, so his 17 18 schedule is unusually tight during this period of time, and he isn't available on either the 20th of April or the 18th 19 20 of May. But he would be available April the 12th or May 21 22 11th or 12th, and those are the days he asked me to suggest to the Commission as possible hearing dates. 23 24 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. Mr. Carr, I think the Commission should take that under --25

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
6 Yes, sir. 1 MR. CARR: CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: -- under advisement --2 MR. CARR: Yes, sir. 3 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: -- and the Commissioners get a 4 chance to look at their schedules. 5 MR. CARR: And if those schedules don't work, Mr. 6 Chairman, I would recommend it be set on the 18th -- well, 7 actually that it be perhaps continued to the 20th and we 8 revisit the question at that time, and perhaps -- maybe the 9 Chairman of the Commission would call Mr. High. 10 You might have a better chance working his 11 schedule than I do. 12 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. So your suggestion is 13 that it be continued to the -- if these dates are not 14 satisfactory to the Commissioners, that it be continued to 15 the --16 MR. CARR: -- 20th of -- at which --17 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: -- April 20th --18 19 MR. CARR: -- time, we have additional dates that 20 I could then present for --21 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. MR. CARR: -- both Mr. High and myself. 22 23 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Will the Commissioners --24 would there be any problem -- Jami brought her schedule, 25 so...

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: April 12th looks good to 1 2 me. COMMISSIONER OLSON: Yeah, I'll be out then, 3 something going on, so... Same on the 11th. The only one 4 5 that works for me, at least of those dates, is the 12th of 6 May. CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: May 12th? 7 COMMISSIONER OLSON: Right. 8 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Something tells me I'm going 9 10 to be busy that day. COMMISSIONER BAILEY: May 12th is okay with me. 11 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay, let me check and see if 12 13 my calendar is available on the 12th. If it is, would there be any problem with the Chairman issuing an order? 14 MR. BROOKS: No, if you want to just do that, I 15 would say let's just continue it from now to April the 16 20th, and then at a later date we can --17 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. 18 MR. BROOKS: -- the Chairman can direct that it 19 20 be set on May the 12th --21 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. 22 MR. BROOKS: -- assuming that all the 23 Commissioners find that an acceptable date. CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. So Cause Number 13,367, 24 25 13,368, and 13,372 shall all be continued until the next
