We received your letter of August 6, 2004, together with data that supports your commerciality determinations for several Fruitland Coal wells within the Gallegos Canyon Unit, San Juan County, New Mexico.

By their letter of September 2, 2004, the Bureau of Land Management advised this office that they have concurred with your determination for the following wells:

Paying Wells:

Gallegos Canyon Unit Well Nos. 159, 173, 193E, 416, 553, 563, 568, 571, and 579.

Non-Paying Wells:

Gallegos Canyon Unit Well Nos. 14, 49, 76, 93, 176E, 192E, 196, 209, 223, 240E, 291, 311, 400E, 411, 566, 569, and 578.

The Commissioner of Public Lands concurs with BP America Production Company's and the Bureau of Land Management's commerciality determinations for the above mentioned wells.

The wells that were determined to be commercial in the Fruitland Coal formation are to be included in the Fruitland Coal participating area. Please submit the appropriate expansion of the Fruitland Coal Participating Area to this office for approval. The wells that were determined non-commercial are to be reported under their lease number or communitization agreement number.
