FUTURE DEVELOPMENT


Poker Lake Unit Well No. 236 – This well will be drilled at a legal location being 660' FSL & 660' FWL, Section 29, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 7,700' to test the Delaware Formation.

Poker Lake Unit Well No. 237– This well will be drilled at a legal location being 660' FSL & 700' FWL, Section 29, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 14,600' to test the Morrow Formation.
