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WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 9:00 a.m.: CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay, good morning, let's go 3 on the record. 4 The August 10th, 2006, meeting of the New Mexico 5 Oil Conservation is hereby called to order. Let the record 6 reflect that it's 9:00 a.m., that the meeting is taking 7 place in Porter Hall, 1220 South St. Francis in Santa Fe, 8 New Mexico. 9 Let the record also reflect that all three 10 Commissioners are present, those Commissioners being Jami 11 Bailey, the designee of the State Land Commissioner, Mr. 12 Bill Olson. 13 The record should also reflect that the 14 Commission secretary, Ms. Florene Davidson, is present; 15 acting as Commission attorney today will be Carol Leach, 16 and that she is present; the Commission record today is 17 18 being taken, as always, by Mr. Steve Brenner, acting for 19 the first time under a new contract, aren't you, today? 20 COURT REPORTER: I believe it's the end of 21 August. 22 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Is it? Okay. 23 With that, the first order of business before the 24 Commission is the adoption of the minutes from the July 25 13th, 2006, meeting. Have the Commissioners had the

opportunity to review the minutes? 1 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move we 2 3 adopt them. CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Is there a second? 4 COMMISSIONER OLSON: Second. 5 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: A motion and second having 6 been heard, all those in favor? 7 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. 8 9 COMMISSIONER OLSON: Aye. 10 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: All those opposed? 11 The minutes as presented are unanimously adopted. Let the record reflect that I will sign the minutes and 12 13 convey them to the Commission secretary. 14 15 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next matter before the 16 17 Commission is a motion for re-hearing in Cases Number 18 13,367, 13,368 and 13,372, the Applications of Bass 19 Enterprises Production and Devon Energy Production, LP, for 20 authorization to drill wells in the potash area, Eddy 21 County, New Mexico. 22 It's the intention of the Chairman to ask the 23 Commissioners to express their desires on how to handle this. I have read the motion for re-hearing. I think that 24 25 even after reading the motion, I believe that the wells as

proposed will result in the waste of potash. It's our duty 1 under the Statutes to prevent undue waste of that mineral. 2 T believe that this order does that. 3 However, it has been brought before the 4 Commission, and I would ask the Commissioners whether they 5 would like to adopt that reasoning or deliberate on this 6 motion for re-hearing to some extent later. 7 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I completely agree with you 8 9 and your reasoning, and I do not believe that this needs to be re-heard. I believe the Commission did its best to take 10 into account all facets of the case. 11 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Commissioner Olson, did you 12 13 have any comment on that? COMMISSIONER OLSON: Just -- I agree with both of 14 15 I think that our order is consistent with protecting you. 16 oil and gas development as well as potash development and in accordance with R-111-P. 17 18 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. With that, the Chair 19 would entertain a motion to deny the application for re-20 hearing of Bass Enterprises Production Company and Devon 21 Energy Production Company. 22 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I so move. 23 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Is there a second? 24 COMMISSIONER OLSON: Second. 25 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: All those in favor?
