**Re:** Administrative application (application reference No. pTDS0-619152979) submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") in Santa Fe, New Mexico on July 10, 2006 to reinstate the provisions of Division Order No. R-7179, issued in Case No. 7761 on January 5, 1983, which order established a 160-acre non-standard gas spacing unit in the Skaggs-Abo Gas Pool (85410) comprising the S/2 NE/4 and the N/2 SE/4 of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, for its C. H. Weir "A" Well No. 12 (API No. 30-025-27398) located at an unorthodox gas well location 2307 feet from the North and East lines (Unit G) of Section 12.

Dear Mr. Lopez:

Due to the following extenuating circumstances associated with your application, the Division is unable to administratively address this matter under the provisions of Division Rule 104.D (2):

- (a) The subject non-standard gas spacing unit does not lay wholly within a single quarter section that is a legal subdivision of the U. S. Public Land Surveys [see Division Rules 104.C (3) and D (2) (b) (ii)].
- (b) This matter was initially approved through the hearing process and the reinstatement of such previous order should also be administered in the same manner.
- (c) This situation is very similar to a problematic incidence that occurred two years ago within a neighboring non-prorated gas pool (see the Division's Memorandum dated June 8, 2004).

This application will therefore be set for hearing before a Division Hearing Examiner on the next available docket scheduled for August 31, 2006. To help expedite this matter I have prepared the following advertisement:

Chevron Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval to re-instate the Non-Standard Proration Unit and Unorthodox Location for the CH Weir A #12 in the Skaggs Abo Gas Pool (Order R-7179). This order was approved on 1/5/1983 after all necessary notifications had been made. The #12 produced from the Abo from 1983 to 1991 when it was plugged back to the Drinkard. The well has currently declined to levels that we would like to re-open the Abo and reinstitute the order.



APPLICATION OF TEXACO INC. FOR TWO NON-STANDARD PRORATION UNITS AND AN UNORTHODOX LOCATION, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

### ORDER OF THE DIVISION

#### BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on December 16, 1982, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this <u>5th</u> day of January, 1983, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

#### FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Texaco Inc., seeks approval of two 160-acre non-standard gas proration units comprising the S/2 NE/4 and N/2 SE/4 of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, to be dedicated to its C. H. Weir "A" Well No. 12 at an unorthodox location 2307 feet from the North line and 2307 feet from the East line of said Section 12, and the S/2 NW/4 and N/2 SW/4 of Section 12 to be dedicated to its C. H. Weir "A" Well No. 14, located 1980 feet from the South line and 1815 feet from the West line of said Section 12.
- (3) That the entire area within said non-standard proration units may reasonably be presumed productive of gas from the Skaggs-Abo Gas Pool and that said non-standard gas proration units can be efficiently and economically drained and developed by the aforesaid wells.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce his just and equitable

share of the gas in the Skaggs-Abo Gas Pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That Texaco Inc. is hereby granted two 160-acre non-standard gas proration units in the Skaggs-Abo Gas Pool comprising the S/2 NE/4 and N/2 SE/4, and the S/2 NW/4 and N/2 SW/4 of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to be dedicated, respectively, to the C. H. Weir "A" Well No. 12 at an unorthodox location, hereby approved, 2307 feet from the North line and 2307 feet from the East line of said Section 12 and to the C. H. Weir Well No. 14 located 1980 feet from the South line and 1815 feet from the West line of said Section 12.
- (2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
