Call for appearances. 6 MR. CARR: Mr. Examiner, my name is William F. 7 Carr with the Santa Fe office of Holland and Hart, L.L.P. 8 We represent OXY USA WTP Limited Partnership in this 9 matter. I have one witness, David Evans, who has 10 previously been sworn and his credentials as an expert in 11 petroleum land matters have been accepted and made a matter 12

MR. CARR: I'd like to advise you, Mr. Examiner, that again this case is similar to the one we presented first for the Admiral Federal, that we have three overriding royalty interest owners, that we have been unable to get their interests committed to the well.

We would have done these by affidavit, but we had other cases that we had to bring to hearing, and so since the witness was here we decided to proceed that way.

5 1 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay. DAVID RAY EVANS, 2 3 the witness herein, having been previously duly sworn upon his oath, was examined and testified as follows: 4 DIRECT EXAMINATION 5 BY MR. CARR: 6 Mr. Evans, are you familiar with the Application 7 0. filed in this case? 8 9 Α. Yes, I am. 10 0. And are you familiar with the status of the lands in the area that's the subject of this Application? 11 Yes, I am. 12 Α. Would you please advise Mr. Catanach what it is 13 Q. that OXY seeks with this Application? 14 We're looking for an order pooling all minerals 15 16 from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation under 17 the following standard unit: the east half of Section 13, 18 located in Township 18 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, 19 New Mexico, the east half for all formations or pools 20 developed on 320, which includes but not limited to the 21 undesignated Red Lake-Atoka-Morrow Gas Pool; the southeast 22 quarter for all formations and pools developed on 160-acre

2	A. OXY Whiptail State Com Well Number 1.
3	Q. And what is the location of that well?
4	A. 950 from the south line, 1900 feet from the east
5	line, Unit O, Section 13.
6	Q. What is the current status of that well?
7	A. Producing.
8	Q. Is it a good well?
9	A. It's a great well.
10	Q. What producing rates have you been able to
11	achieve?
12	A. Initially at about 43 million, and currently at
13	about 21.
14	Q. Could you refer to what has been marked OXY
15	Exhibit Number 1?
16	A. That is our plat for the OXY Whiptail State Com
17	Number 1, reflecting the well location in Section 13, the
18	east half.
19	Q. And on this exhibit you have indicated the three
20	overriding royalty interest owners that you've been unable
21	to get voluntary in the well, and those interests are shown
22	over the tracts in which they own their interest; is that
23	correct?
24	A. That's correct.
25	Q. And this well is producing from what formation?

The Morrow formation. 1 Α. Is the development of this acreage governed by 2 Q. statewide rules? 3 4 Α. Yes, they are. Would you identify for the record the names and 5 Q. the percentage overriding royalty interest of each three 6 7 owners who you seek to be pooled? The heirs of Steve Falletti, who owns a .0068359-8 percent override; the heirs of Milton and Ruby Kuschke, 9 .006835-percent override; and Russell Folsom, .0068359 10 11 percent. A hundred percent of the working interest has 12 0. been voluntarily committed to the well --13 That's correct. 14 Α. -- and the com agreement has been approved by the 15 Commissioner of Public Lands and by the Bureau of Land 16 17 Management; is that right? 18 Α. That's right. And a copy of that com agreement bearing the 19 Q. 20 signatures of the working interest owners is attached 21 hereto as Exhibit Number 2; is that right? 22 Α. That's right. 23 Let's go to Exhibit Number 3, and I'd ask you to Q. briefly review the efforts you've made to identify these 24 25 interest owners.

A. Letters -- We hired a California land broker to find Steve Falletti, through Doug Rowan, and that is dated May the 17th. Found a death certificate of Steve Falletti on June 2nd. You'll note there's no heirs of Steve Falletti, he died a single man in the 1950s. Yates Petroleum provided an old Division order with an old address of 1959.

And we simply were unable to find the heirs of Milton and Ruby Kuschke, spent about \$14,254 looking for the override owners through Doug Rowan.

Q. What about Russell Folsom?

- A. Russell Folsom also, uh-huh. And that was provided -- that information was provided by Yates, and it was as old as 1959.
- Q. Have you made a good faith effort to locate each of these interest owners?
- A. We've gone on various websites like gravesite.com, the heirship websites, spent at least three months looking for these people.
- Q. What will you do with the proceeds that are attributable to these interest owners?
- A. Accounts will be set up in Eddy County, and moneys will be disbursed to those bank accounts.
 - Q. And held there until -- ?
- A. Held there until someone can claim the moneys.

1	Q. And if they don't, they'll escheat to the State
2	of New Mexico at some time; is that right?
3	A. That's correct.
4	Q. In Exhibit Number 3 is a copy of various
5	documents that evidence your efforts to locate these
6	individuals?
7	A. That's correct.
8	Q. As overriding royalty interests, they're not
9	subject to an AFE, they don't pay costs
10	A. No, sir.
11	Q they don't sign the
12	A operating agreement.
13	Q subject to the JOA, and the overhead and
14	administrative costs and the risk penalties do not apply,
15	do they?
16	A. That's correct.
17	Q. Does OXY USA WTP Limited Partnership seek to be
18	designated operator of the well?
19	A. Yes.
20	Q. No notice was provided, because the whereabouts
21	of these individuals is unknown; is that right?
22	A. That's correct.
23	Q. Were Exhibits 1 through 3 prepared by you or
24	compiled under your direction?

MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, at this 1 time we'd move the admission into evidence of OXY Exhibits 2 3 1 through 3. EXAMINER CATANACH: Exhibits 1 through 3 will be 4 5 admitted. MR. CARR: And that concludes my direct 6 7 examination of Mr. Evans. **EXAMINATION** 8 BY EXAMINER CATANACH: 9 What types of leases are involved in this unit? 10 Q. These are -- I want to say they're state leases. 11 Α. MR. CARR: Mr. Catanach, they're shown on Exhibit 12 13 1, the --THE WITNESS: State of New Mexico. 14 MR. CARR: One State of New Mexico, and the other 15 is a federal lease, and that's why the BLM approved the com 16 17 agreement. THE WITNESS: Correct. 18 19 The OXY tract is federal, the Pogo MR. CARR: tract is state. 20 21 THE WITNESS: These are actually -- there are 22 one, two, three, four -- five state leases and one federal. 23 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, again, I notice that when you were reciting your units, you did not mention that 24 25 you -- The advertisement for the case actually does request

1	a 80-acre units again.
2	MR. CARR: And again, that's incorrect.
3	EXAMINER CATANACH: It is incorrect?
4	MR. CARR: Yeah. We should have pulled those.
5	We were doing them sort of en masse. We do check every
6	time.
7	EXAMINER CATANACH: So we need to delete the 80-
8	acre unit?
9	MR. CARR: Yes, we do.
10	Q. (By Examiner Catanach) So the Falletti interest,
11	you know that he is deceased?
12	A. Correct.
13	Q. And you couldn't find any heirs?
14	A. Found that the body shipped back to Illinois and
15	but we couldn't find any heirs, not as of yet. We sent
16	some letters out to Fallettis in Illinois, hoping to find
17	someone.
18	Q. And the other two you just could not find at all?
19	A. That's correct.
20	MR. CARR: Mr. Falletti actually died as an
21	indigent, and held this interest all that time.
22	THE WITNESS: Yeah.
23	Q. (By Examiner Catanach) So his interest is
24	derived he had it for a long period of time?
25	A. Yes, sir. We've tracked part of his what we

1	thought was back to Italy, but it was not.
2	Q. Did the other two interest owners have their
3	interest for a long time as well?
4	A. Yes.
5	Q. So these were leases that were effective back
6	A 1930s, I think.
7	Q. 1930?
8	A. I'm going to say that, 1930s 1950s, I'm sorry.
9	Q. Just never drilled?
10	A. There may be some shallow production. Yates
11	hasn't known any addresses since 1959 for theirs, so
12	Q. Hm. Well there are some documents dated 1938.
13	A. Yeah.
14	EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay.
15	MR. CARR: Would you like a proposed order on
16	this one too, since it will be very much like the Admiral
17	Federal?
18	EXAMINER CATANACH: No, I think I can just go off
19	that one, I think. I probably can find a similar one that
20	I've issued, but if you would
21	MR. CARR: We'll look for a similar one you've
22	issued, send it back to you.
23	EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay.
24	MS. MacQUESTEN: Mr. Carr, do you have an
25	affidavit of publication?

1	MR. CARR: No because, see, there was no way to -
2	- We have no addresses for any of these entities, so
3	MS. MacQUESTEN: Was it published in the
4	newspaper?
5	MR. CARR: Oh, yes, it was, yes, and I'll provide
6	that. I do have that, yes. Yes, I will get that bring
