## STATEMENT OF THE CASE

#### **APPLICANT**

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from approximately 11,920 feet subsurface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the E/2 of Section 23, Township 20 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 320 acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the West Osudo-Morrow Gas Pool. The unit is to be dedicated to the Byers Well No. 2, to be drilled

at an orthodox gas well location in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 23. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. Applicant also request that an overriding royalty owned by Magnolia, L.L.C. be disallowed for purposes of recovering the risk charge under the pooling orders for the existing Byers Well No. 1 (Order No. R-12050) and for the proposed Byers Well No. 2.
