WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 8:19 a.m.: EXAMINER EZEANYIM: We'll go back to page 1 and 3 then call Case Number 13,786. This case was also continued 4 from September 28th Examiner Hearing, and this is the 5 Application of Cimarex Energy Company for compulsory 6 pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. 7 Call for appearances. 8 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, 9 representing the Applicant. I'm submitting this case by 10 affidavit. 11 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Any other appearances? 12 13 Okay, Mr. Bruce, you may continue. MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I've handed you a 14 15 package of exhibits. Exhibit 1 is the affidavit of the landman for 16 17 Cimarex Energy Company. If you'd turn to Exhibit A to the exhibit, the land plat --18 19 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay. 20 MR. BRUCE: -- and even the page before that, Mr. 21 Examiner. There are -- Exhibit A is two pages. 22 The Applicant seeks to force pool the north half of Section 17, Township 15 South, Range 36 East. 23 24 land plat. And then attached -- part of Exhibit A, the

next page, is the C-102 for the well, showing that it's at

an orthodox location 880 feet. The well, the Caudill West
17 Fee Number 1, is located 880 feet from the north line
and 660 feet from the east line.

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Can you repeat that, please?

MR. BRUCE: 880 from the north line and 660 from the east line.

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay.

MR. BRUCE: Attached as Exhibit B is a listing of the -- this is all fee land. Attached as Exhibit B is a listing of the people who have not yet either leased their lands or agreed to participate in the well.

This is an old -- you know, a fee tract -- two fee tracts that were patented in the early part of the 1900s, and there are many, many owners. About 15 percent, maybe 14 percent, of the owners remain unleased, and these are -- on Exhibit B which is four pages, it lists all the interest owners and their percentage interest in the 320-acre well unit. You can see that a lot of these interests are quite small.

The Applicant has tried to lease these interest owners or ask them to join in the well. I've provided them with an AFE, and attached as Exhibit C is the correspondence with these interest owners. There was -- in addition to this correspondence, there were numerous phone calls made to many of these parties and e-mails exchange

with a number of these parties, but they have not yet agreed to lease.

Attached as Exhibit D is the AFE for the well, which is a -- it's a Mississippian test, and it has a completed well cost of \$3,131,000, so it's a pretty expensive well.

The overhead rates requested by the Applicant are \$6000 a month for a drilling well and \$600 for a producing well, and these are common rates in this area.

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: How much is that again?
MR. BRUCE: \$6000 and \$600.

Submitted as Exhibit 2 is my affidavit of notice, and written notice was provided to everyone, although there are some unlocatable people.

And an affidavit was published -- I mean, excuse me, a notice was published in the Hobbs newspaper, and that notice is marked as Exhibit 3.

After doing this, there were a few people who were locatable but did not accept their certified mail, and so I have re-published notice so that all of these people were also notified. I do not have that affidavit of notice back yet, and so I'd ask that the case be continued for two weeks so I can submit that additional notice affidavit -- I mean, excuse me, publication affidavit. But all of the people have been given notice, either by mail or by

1 | publication.

And I'd ask that Exhibits 1 through 3 be made part of the record in this case.

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: At this time Exhibits 1 through 3 will be admitted into evidence.

If I may ask some few questions here, I know this case will be continued, and I think at the point when it's continued we will need to get your newspaper publication, because there is need of going through the case at that point.

MR. BRUCE: Yeah.

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: At that point that case may then be taken under advisement. So at that point get some clarification or something, things that I needed to know.

Of all the working interests, how many working interests in this north-half unit? Do you know?

MR. BRUCE: There's really only two working interests -- I mean two lessees. One is the Applicant, Cimarex Energy Company, and then the other one is Chalfant Properties -- that's C-h-a-l-f-a-n-t Properties -- out of Midland, who is a -- that's a brokerage. I'm guessing that that was probably leased for Chesapeake Energy, although I do not know that.

All of these other people listed in Exhibit 1 are unleased mineral owners.

So out of those two --EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay. 1 how many of them have committed? All of them or just --2 none of them? 3 MR. BRUCE: On Exhibit B attached to Exhibit 1, 4 none of these people are committed at this time, they are 5 all unleased. 6 Several -- The Applicant continues to take 7 leases, and I believe about maybe eight or 10 of these 8 people are still negotiating a lease, and if any of them do 9 lease I will notify the Division. 10 But at this point all of the people on Exhibit B 11 are unleased, except -- if you look at the first page of 12 Exhibit 4, down in the middle, Chalfant Properties, Inc., 13 they are a lessee, but they have not --14 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: -- been contacted? 15 MR. BRUCE: -- they have not signed a JOA yet. 16 17 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay. MR. BRUCE: They are the person or the company 18 19 that they leased for. 20 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Since the well is on a standard location, do you -- have you gotten an APD or --21 whether or not any --22 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I will get that for 23 24 I believe there is an APD, and I had it in my file. 25 I do not have it right now.
