- 2. Operator has posted the following applicable financial assurance: \$50,000 blanket surety bond number 980F9988, issued by The Traverlers Indemnity Company.
- 3. The subject well has been inactive for more than one year plus ninety days, and has not been approved for temporary abandonment. This well is accordingly in violation of Division Rule 201.

WHEREFORE, the Supervisor of District I of the Division requests an order:

A. Determining that the subject well should be plugged and abandoned in accordance with a Division-approved plugging program.

- B. Directing the Operator to plug the subject well by a date certain, and thereafter to remediate the site in accordance with OCD Rules.
- C. Ordering that if the Operator does not plug the subject well within the time provided, the Division be authorized: (i) to plug the subject well and remediate the site; (ii) to declare forfeit the above-described financial assurance; and (iii) to take necessary and appropriate measures to recover from the Operator any costs of plugging the subject well in excess of the amount of the applicable financial assurance.
