This well location will no longer be unorthodox.

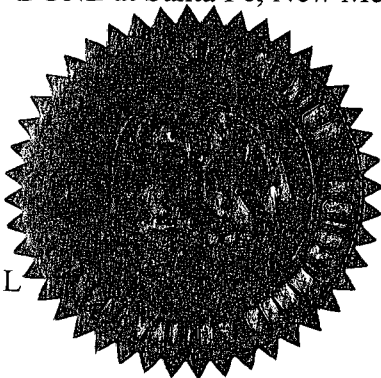
2. This application should be dismissed.
