APPLICATION OF MEWBOURNE OIL COMPANY FOR COMPULSORY POOLING, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company applies for an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying Section 6, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, state:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in Section 6, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill its Osudo North "6" Well No. 1, at an orthodox location in the NW¼SE¼ of Section 6, to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation, and seeks to dedicate the following acreage to the well:
 - (a) Lots 1, 2, S½NE¼, and SE¼ (the E½) to form a standard 320.31 acre gas spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 320 acre spacing within that vertical extent; and
 - (b) Lots 1-7, S½NE¼, SE¼NW¼, E½SW¼, and SE¼ (All) to form a standard 637.18 acre gas spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 640 acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the North Osudo-Morrow Gas Pool.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in Section 6 for the purposes set forth herein.

4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in Section 6, pursuant to

NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interests underlying Section 6 will prevent the drilling

of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

A. Pooling all mineral interests in Section 6, from the surface to the base of the

Morrow formation;

B. Designating applicant as operator of the well;

C. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost

among the well's working interest owners;

D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together

with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and

E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in

the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the following described acreage in Section 6, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, and in the following manner: Lots 1-7, S/2NE/4, SE/4NW/4, E/2SW/4, and SE/4 (All) to form a standard 637.18-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 640-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the North Osudo-Morrow Gas Pool; and Lots 1, 2, S/2NE/4, and SE/4 (the E/2) to form a standard 320.31-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent.
