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1	WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at
2	9:55 a.m.:
3	EXAMINER JONES: And at this time let's call Case
4	13,838 I'm sorry, let's start over 13,840,
5	Application of Devon Energy Production Company, LP, for
6	compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.
7	Call for appearances.
8	MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe,
9	representing the Applicant. I'm also submitting this case
10	by affidavit.
11	Mr. Examiner, Exhibit 1 is an affidavit by Meg
12	Muhlinghause, landman for Devon Energy. Devon seeks to
13	force pool the south half of Section 10, 19 South, 31 East.
14	This is a Morrow test well.
15	Information on the parties being pooled and their
16	interests in the well unit are attached as Exhibit B to
17	Exhibit 1.
18	Exhibit C contains correspondence to the parties.
19	The original letter went out on September 14th, 2006.
20	And then submitted as Exhibit D is an AFE for the
21	well. This well is a mere \$2.6 million. Just like in the
22	other cases, this affidavit does contain information on the
23	requested overhead rates which are \$6000 and \$600 a month,
24	and they request that they be adjusted under the COPAS
25	accounting procedure, as is common in all the other cases.

Submitted as Exhibit 2 is my affidavit of notice. 1 I notice mine wasn't numbered. Is yours numbered, on the 2 front page? 3 EXAMINER JONES: Yes. 4 MR. BRUCE: 5 Okay --EXAMINER JONES: Oh, no, no, it's not. Exhibit 6 Number 2? 7 Should be Exhibit 2. 8 MR. BRUCE: Notice was sent by certified mail to all parties. 9 Amity Oil, Inc., which is an existing company, I never did 10 11 get the green card back from them. I would ask as a 12 result, I think the matter should be continued to January 13 4th, just so I can verify that notice has been received by Amity Oil Company. But all of the other parties being 14 pooled did receive notice. 15 The parties are in ongoing discussions, and 16 chances are that a number of these parties will join in the 17 18 well, at which time I will notify the Division that they wouldn't be subject to a pooling order. 19 20 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, now say that again. You 21 want to continue to --22 MR. BRUCE: January 4th, because for some reason 23 I never got the green card back from Amity Oil Company, and 24 that's the very last page of Exhibit 2. 25 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, okay.

Is this also a Morrow test? MR. BROOKS: 1 MR. BRUCE: It is also a Morrow test. 2 MR. BROOKS: What depth? 3 I think it is -- I think it's MR. BRUCE: 4 5 shallower than the others. It is -- No, it's deeper. 6 12,725 feet. 7 MR. BROOKS: Wonder why the AFE is so much less than some of the others? 8 9 MR. BRUCE: That I do not know. I think in some of these areas, for whatever reason, the drilling in the 10 Morrow goes a little easier than in other areas, for 11 reasons that the Hearing Examiner might know better than 12 13 me. MR. BROOKS: Very likely. 14 EXAMINER JONES: Yeah, it looks like -- You're 15 going for 320, 160 and 40-acre tracts? 16 17 MR. BRUCE: Correct. Yeah, the 160, this is in 18 the old Lusk-Strawn Pool. I don't know if the Lusk-Strawn is paid out or is even existent in this particular section, 19 20 but it is in that pool. 21 EXAMINER JONES: Okay. Yeah, I found a Morrow 22 pool, a Strawn pool, and basically four 40-acre pools in 23 this area. 24 Okay, we'll -- with that, we'll continue Case 13,840 to January the 4th, and at that time we'll get a 25
