We'll call Case Number 13,489 [sic], 4 Application of XTO Energy, Inc., for compulsory pooling, 5 San Juan County, New Mexico. 6 7 Call for appearances. MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, 8 representing the Applicant. I'm submitting this case by 9 affidavit. 10 Any other appearances? EXAMINER BROOKS: 11 Very good, you may proceed. 12 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, marked as Exhibit 1 is 13 the landman [sic] of Christopher Spencer, who is a landman 14 for XTO Energy, Inc. XTO seeks the force pooling of the 15 west-half equivalent of Section 5, Township 30 North, Range 16 Fortunately, it is a 320.72-acre unit, after 17 13 West. the --18 19 (Laughter) 20 MR. BRUCE: And they are seeking the force 21 pooling of two wells. One well, the Lunt Well Number 1 in the northwest quarter, and a Lunt Number 2 in the southwest 22 23 quarter of Section 5. 24 The party lists the three people being force 25 pooled. Each own about 1 1/4 percent. The interests being

pooled are the beneficiaries of a gentleman, and they had to search far and wide to find these people. They found almost all of them except one, who's apparently unlocatable. The affidavit contains a request for the 200-percent risk charge and contains overhead rates.

Exhibit B attached to this exhibit is the correspondence sent to these parties.

And Exhibits C and D are the AFEs for the two wells involved. There were originally about eight or -- no, there were originally about 10 heirs of this gentleman, and XTO tracked them down.

Submitted as Exhibit 2 is the affidavit of notice. More people were notified than we are pooling. At this time we are only seeking to pool Mr. Mann, Jack Pierson and Harvey Dell Cranmore.

The -- I did a bad copy, but it's -- Harvey Dell Cranmore is a woman, and she was -- the correspondence to her is addressed to Ms. Cranmore. She was not locatable. The last page of Exhibit 2, I apparently copied the wrong side of the returned envelope. She was not locatable, and an advertisement was -- or a notice was published in the Farmington newspaper, and that is attached as Exhibit 3.
