WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 9:06 a.m.: 2 Call Case 13,871, the 3 EXAMINER CATANACH: Application of EOG Resources, Inc., for compulsory pooling, 4 5 Eddy County, New Mexico. Call for appearances. 6 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Good morning, Mr. Hearing 7 Examiner. Ocean Munds-Dry with Holland and Hart, here 8 representing EOG Resources, Inc., this morning. 9 presenting this case by affidavit. 10 11 EXAMINER CATANACH: Any additional appearances? 12 Okay, you may proceed. MS. MUNDS-DRY: Thank you, Mr. Examiner. 13 If you'll turn to Exhibit 1, it is the affidavit 14 of Richard L. Lanning, who is on behalf of EOG seeking an 15 order pooling certain unfound interest owners in the east 16 17 half of irregular Section 5, Township 16 South, Range 25 East, in Eddy County, New Mexico. 18 19

EOG owns a working interest in the east half of Section 5 and seeks to dedicate a horizontal well, so a proposed project area, to its Tiber B 5 fee well Number 1H, which they propose to drill from a surface location of 187 feet from the south line, 2239 from the east line, to a bottomhole location of 2448 from the north line and 1880 from the east line of said irregular Section 5.

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If you'll please turn to Attachment A you'll see it's the C-102 for the well, showing the proposed project area, producing area and the well location.

The proposed project area consists entirely of fee leases, and if you'll please turn to Attachment B this attachment shows the nature and percentage of the ownership interests in the subject area. All interest owners have voluntarily committed their interest to the proposed spacing unit, except for three interest owners who have not been found.

And you'll see on the attachment they're listed towards the bottom. The interests are Donald R. Schaub, Helen J. Triggs and Audrey M. DeMartino. They own collectively in the spacing unit a total of .000375 percent in the spacing unit, so it's a relatively small interest.

and if you'll turn to Attachment C this is a letter sent by their broker, which is actually the envelope showing that it came back marked as "Deceased", and the green card, and then the letter back to Mr. Lanning indicating their efforts to locate these individuals. They found them in the county records, and there is a lease from 1978 that they found the address.

In addition to sending the proposal to lease the interests to this last known address, they also searched

other county records, including probates, deeds, any other leases or instruments that would have been recorded in the county records. The broker also performed an Internet search for these individuals and employed certain phone databases to attempt to locate them, and they were not found.

EOG therefore requests that the interests of these individuals be pooled and EOG be designated the operator of the well in the project area. EOG proposes overhead rates of \$4500 per month while drilling and \$450 per month while producing.

And Attachment D is a copy of the AFE that was put together in December of 2006. This AFE was not sent to these interest owners because they didn't have, as you saw in Attachment C, a good address to send it to them, as it was returned previously. But this is what has been submitted to the other interest owners.

And then finally Attachment E is a copy of the affidavit of publication in *The Artesia Daily Press*, my affidavit showing that we gave notice of this hearing to that last known address which you see on Exhibit A, and the green cards which also came back marked Attempted, Not Known. Those were all returned.

Approval of this Application will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells and prevent waste, will

1	protect correlative rights and allow EOG and the other
2	interest owners in the east half of Section 5 an
3	opportunity to obtain their just and fair share of the oil
4	and gas under the subject lands.
5	That concludes Mr. Lanning's affidavit, and I
6	would move the admission of Exhibit 1 and its attachments.
