Applicant seeks an order granting an exception to Division Order No. R-111-P so that it is not required to cement production strings to the surface on wells drilled to the Delaware and Bone Spring formations on state and fee lands covering all of Sections 24, 25, and 36, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, and the W/2 of Section 19, W/2 of Section 30, and NW/4 and W/2SW/4 of Section 31, Township 23 South, Range 30 East, NMPM.
