3 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: At this time we'll go ahead
4 and call the regularly scheduled May 18th, 2006, meeting of
5 the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to order.

6 As previously stated, it is the regularly
7 scheduled meeting, so we have two items of housekeeping we
8 need to take up before we begin.

9 First of all, let the record reflect that it's
10 nine o'clock a.m., Thursday, May 18th, 2006, that all three
11 Commissioners are present, therefore there is a quorum
12 present.

13 There are two cases that are on the docket to be
14 continued.

15 The first is Cause Number 13,492, the Application
16 for hearing *de novo* of Samson Resources Company, Kaiser-
17 Francis Oil Company, and Mewbourne Oil Company for
18 cancellation of two drilling permits and approval of a
19 drilling permit in Lea County, New Mexico. Again, let the
20 record reflect that that case will be continued to the
21 August 10th, 2006, Commission meeting.

22 The second case that's on the docket for today
23 that will be continued is Cause Number 13,493, the
24 Application for hearing *de novo* of the Application of
25 Chesapeake Permian, L.P., for compulsory pooling in Lea

1 County, New Mexico. That case also will be continued to
2 the August 10th, 2006, regularly scheduled Commission
3 meeting in this room.


