Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. seeks an exception to Rule 19.15.5.303A NMAC to authorize the surface commingling of production from the Ingle Wells-Delaware Pool originating from its wells located on Federal Oil and Gas Leases NM 0418220-A and NM 0405444-A, which collectively comprise all of Section 26, Township 23 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M..
