Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your request received by the Santa Fe Office of the Division on March 7, 2007, to increase the surface injection pressure on the Ross Draw Unit Well No. 9. This request is based on a step rate injection test that was conducted on the well on January 30, 2007. The step rate test data shows that approval of the request will not result in the fracturing of the injection formation and confining strata.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

Ross Draw Unit Well No. 9 API No. 30-015-23224 Unit C, Section 34, Township 26 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico	1000 PSIG

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected fluid is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
