JONES, Jr., Hearing Examiner, New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, on Thursday, March 15th, 2007, at the New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, 1220 South Saint Francis Drive, Room 102, Santa Fe, New Mexico, Steven T. Brenner, Certified Court Reporter No. 7 for the State of New Mexico.

Continued and Dismissed Cases

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1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at
2 8:17 a.m.:

3 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, let's go on the hearing --
4 go on the clock this morning, and let's call the Examiner
5 Hearing on March 15th, 2007. This is Docket Number 9-07.

6 I'm William V. Jones. This is David Brooks,
7 attorney for the Division this morning.

8 Let's first call the continuances and dismissals,
9 and you can correct me if I'm wrong on some of these.

10 Page 1, Case Number 13,884 is dismissed. Case
11 Number 13,885 is continued for six weeks; I take that to be
12 April the 26th.

13 MR. BROOKS: I believe that's right.

14 EXAMINER JONES: If I'm wrong on that, we'll
15 continue it for six weeks.

16 On page 2, no continuances or dismissals.

17 On page 3, Case 13,872 is dismissed.

18 On page 4, Case 13,663 is continued to April
19 12th; Case 13,787 continued to April 12th; Case 13,493
20 continued to March 29th.

21 And on page 5, Case 13,853 is continued to March
22 29th; Case 13,856 continued to March 29th; Case 13,877
23 continued to April 12th.

24 Any other continuances or dismissals?

25 MS. O'CONNOR: Yes, Mr. Hearing Examiner. Cheryl

1 O'Connor of the Oil Conservation Division, and we would
2 like to continue the Case Number 13,886, Reubin Collins
3 doing business as RCJ Enterprises. We would like to
4 continue that for two weeks.

5 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, that would be the end of
6 March, we'll continue -- March 29th, we'll continue that
7 case.

8 Any other continuances or dismissals?

9 Unfortunately not, I guess.

10 MR. EZEANYIM: Excuse me, on page 3 Case Number
11 13,814 was inadvertently put on this docket. It's not
12 supposed to be on this docket at all. It was taken care of
13 last -- I think March 1 --

14 EXAMINER JONES: Okay --

15 MR. EZEANYIM: -- so you don't need to worry
16 about that.

17 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, thank you. Case 13,814 is
18 not even a part of this docket, so we'll have that on the
19 record.

20 An other continuances or dismissals? Okay.

21 MR. CARR: Mr. Examiner, Case 13,629 is a case
22 that was reopened by the Division concerning special pool
23 rules for the Sand Springs-Permo Upper Penn. Yates was the
24 Applicant in that original case. They've decided to let
25 the rules expire.

1 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, I've never been involved
2 with a case where they've let that happen, so in that case
3 we just don't even call it this morning. We'll just
4 dismiss this case --

5 MR. CARR: That's fine with us.

6 EXAMINER JONES: -- and by default it will
7 expire, special pool rules. So Case 13,629 is dismissed.

8 Thank you.

9 (Off the record at 8:19 a.m.)

10 (The following proceedings had at 9:58 a.m.)

11 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, let's go back on the
12 record here, and I guess the first thing I need to do is
13 revisit Case Number 13,629.

14 This morning I mentioned that the case will be
15 dismissed, and I will be writing an order in that case with
16 the finding that Yates no longer wants these --

17 MR. CARR: And --

18 EXAMINER JONES: -- pools.

19 MR. CARR: Yes, sir.

20 EXAMINER JONES: Okay.

21 MR. CARR: And also, Mr. Examiner, there was a
22 comment about a Pride case that was on the docket, and it
23 said it shouldn't be on the docket. There was an error on
24 that ad, and it has been readvertised for the hearing, I
25 believe April the 12th. But you don't have to do anything,

1 but that case is automatically --

2 EXAMINER JONES: Okay.

3 MR. CARR: -- going forward while the ad is being
4 pulled.

5 EXAMINER JONES: I will tell Florene that.

6 MR. CARR: I have already told her that.

7 EXAMINER JONES: Okay.

8 MR. CARR: Yeah.

9 EXAMINER JONES: And that's on the record here
10 now too. So that Case Number 13,629 will be taken under
11 advisement, actually.

12 (Thereupon, these proceedings were concluded at
13 9:59 a.m.)


