## Dear Mr. Fesmire:

The Division previously granted an extension to commence drilling the subject well from April 30<sup>th</sup> to June 30<sup>th</sup>, based on a delay in obtaining a right-of-way to the wellsite from the BLM. The BLM subsequently required the operator to take a different route to the location than originally planned, which meant re-surveying and re-permitting with the BLM. The BLM has now approved the right-of-way, and the operator has commencing construction the road and location. Due to the length of the road, which has to cross over several draws, the operator may not have the location ready in time to spud the well by June 30th.

Therefore, Corkran Energy, LP requests an extra month (to July 30, 2007) to commence drilling the well.
