APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company applies for an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the S½ of Section 3, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 3, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill its Sharps Fed. Com. Well No. 1, at an orthodox location in the NW¼SW¼ of Section 3, to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation, and seeks to dedicate the S½ of Section 3 to the well to form a standard 320 acre gas and spacing and proration unit for all pools or formations developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the East Burton Flat-Strawn Gas Pool, West Parkway-Atoka Gas Pool, and East Burton Flat-Morrow Gas Pool.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 3 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 3, pursuant to NMSA 1978 870-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interests underlying the S½ of Section 3 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all mineral interests in the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 3, from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation;
- B. Designating applicant as operator of the well;
- C. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost among the well's working interest owners;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the S/2 of Section 3, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all pools or formations developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the East Burton Flat-Strawn Gas Pool, West Parkway-Atoka Gas Pool, and East Burton Flat-Morrow Gas Pool. The unit is to be dedicated to the proposed Sharps 3 Fed. Com. Well No. 1, to be drilled at an orthodox location in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 3. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
