WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 8:59 a.m.: EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Now I call Case Number 3 This is the Application of EOG Resources, Inc., 4 for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. 5 Call for appearances. 6 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Good morning, Mr. Hearing 7 Examiner. Ocean Munds-Dry with the law firm of Holland and 8 9 Hart, here representing EOG Resources, Inc., this morning. EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Any other appearances? 10 11 Okay. You are presenting by affidavit? 12 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Yes, sir. EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Go ahead. 13 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Thank you, Mr. Examiner. EOG is 14 15 requesting an order pooling certain interest owners in the north half of Section 5, Township 16 South, Range 25 East 16 in Eddy County. This case will be presented by the 17 affidavit of Richard L. Lanning. 18 All mineral owners in the proposed unit area have 19 voluntarily agreed to pool their interest. However, EOG 20 has been unable to find one mineral interest owner in this 21 22 case. 23 If you'll please turn to Exhibit Number 1, it's 24 Mr. Lanning's affidavit, and he outlines the efforts to 25 search for H.M. Brewster.

Beginning on the end of page 1 and the top of page 2, Mr. Lanning discusses their efforts. They searched county records of Eddy County, and they found that Mr. Brewster had acquired a mineral deed in 1920. However, the only address listed on the mineral deed was Cook County, Illinois, which as you may know is Chicago, so it's a rather large area to try to track down somebody. But he has a full mineral interest in the south 60 acres of Lots 7 and 8 of the proposed spacing unit.

They did perform an Internet search for Mr.

Brewster. Brewster is apparently a very popular name in Chicago, so that further compounded the problem of finding the correct person. They also searched probate records in Cook County in Illinois and were unable to find any specific records, and also conducted a telephone search of Brewsters in the Chicago area. They reached many Brewsters but none that could identify this particular H.M. Brewster. So they were unable to find this particular H.M. Brewster.

Attachment A to the affidavit is the C-102. It shows you the plat, the proposed project area, the producing area and the well location. I should mention to you that this proposed spacing unit is a 220-acre spacing unit. It was previously approved as a nonstandard spacing unit by administrative order NSP-1917.

Attachment B to the affidavit lists the nature

and percentage of all the ownership interests in the proposed project area. Mr. Lanning has broken it down by tract. There's three tracts there. As you can see, Tract 2 is Mr. Brewster's tract, consisting of 60 acres.

Attachment C is the AFE that has been proposed to lease those interest owners that have been located and shows the dryhole and completion costs.

EOG proposes overhead charges pursuant to COPAS of \$4500 a month while drilling and \$450 per month while producing. EOG requests that this interest be pooled and EOG designated the operator of the well in the project area.

And then finally Attachment D to his affidavit is not only my affidavit indicating that notice was given pursuant to Division Rules, also the affidavit of publication. And because we had no address for Mr.

Brewster, we obviously could not notify him by letter.

As Mr. Lanning testifies to in his affidavit, approval of this Application will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights and allow EOG and the other interest owners in the north half of Section 5 an opportunity to obtain their just and fair share underlying the subject lands.

And with that, Mr. Examiner, we would ask that

1 you admit Exhibit 1 and all of its attachments into 2 evidence. 3 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Exhibits 1 and all the 4 attachments will be admitted. 5 MS. MUNDS-DRY: And unless you have any 6 questions, Mr. Examiner, we would ask you to take this case 7 under advisement. 8 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Do you have any questions? 9 EXAMINER BROOKS: No questions. 10 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: I'm looking at the plat that 11 was supplied. Do you know where the perforations will be? 12 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Mr. Examiner, I do not know that. 13 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Because I can see your 14 penetration point, entry point. MS. MUNDS-DRY: I don't know the -- I can't tell 15 16 you the exact footages. I can tell you that this is a 17 Wolfcamp horizontal well, as EOG has been drilling so many 18 of these, as you know --19 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Yeah. 20 MS. MUNDS-DRY: -- and they plan to go to a depth of approximately 5200 feet. But I don't know all the 21 22 perforations. 23 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay, yeah. Are you 24 pooling from the surface to the Wolfcamp, or just the 25 Wolfcamp?

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MS. MUNDS-DRY: From the surface to the Wolfcamp.
