REPORTER'S CERTIFICATE

WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 8:18 a.m.: EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, we are ready to begin. 3 It is Thursday, August 23rd, shortly after 8:15 a.m. We're 4 in Porter Hall. This is Examiner Docket Number 25-07. I'm 5 David Brooks, I'm the presiding Examiner this morning. 6 7 There are a few cases on which we will have a Technical Examiner present, but when we get to those cases 8 we will summon the Technical Examiner. 9 First item of business is to announce 10 continuances and dismissals. 11 On page 1, Case Number 13,942 is continued till 12 September the 20th. 13 On page 2, Case 13,963 is dismissed. 14 On page 3, Case 13,972 is continued till 15 16 September 20th; Case 13,973 is continued till September the 17 20th. On page 4, Case 13,977 is dismissed; Case 13,978 18 19 continued till September 6th. 20 On page 5, Case 13,945 is continued till 21 September the 6th; 13,912 is continued till September the 6th. 22 23 On page 6, 13,952 is continued till September the 6th; 13,940 is continued till September the 20th. 24 25 Are there any other continuances and dismissals?

CARR: May it please the Examiner, on page 5, 1 Case 13,928, Application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for 2 compulsory pooling, Yates requests that case be dismissed. 3 EXAMINER BROOKS: Case 13,928 is dismissed. 4 Other continuances and dismissals? 5 Mr. Hall? 6 MR. HALL: Mr. Examiner, on page 6, Case 13,957, 7 8 we ask that that case be continued to September 6th. We'll 9 be requesting a case-status conference in that one prior to 10 hearing. EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, Case 13,957 will be 11 continued till September the 6th. 12 Any others? 13 14 Jim, did you want to speak to Case 13,975? 15 MR. BRUCE: Yes, Mr. Examiner, that's the Application of Devon Energy. Devon Energy requests that 16 that case be continued for four weeks. Although I didn't 17 receive it, I understand that Mr. Shackelford of 18 Shackelford Oil Company entered an appearance. 19 20 EXAMINER BROOKS: Yes, Mr. Don Shackelford 21 entered an appearance in Case Number 13,975. Is Mr. Shackelford here? 22 23 In view of the fact that he has not appeared for 24 the hearing, Mr. Bruce, Case 13,975 will be continued until 25 September the 20th.

5 Okay, we have a much shorter docket than I 1 thought we were having today, but it's still a fairly 2 substantial docket. Assuming we don't get through by 11:30 3 -- and I'm inclined to think we won't -- we will be taking 4 5 a luncheon recess at 11:30, as I have a medical appointment 6 today. It's not one of those I'll have to wait a long time 7 on, so we should be back soon after 1:00, but we will need 8 to take a recess at 11:30. (Off the record at 8:21 a.m.) 9 (The following proceedings had at 9:08 a.m.) 10 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, previous statement of the 11 Examiner dismissing Case Number 13,963 is vacated, and Case 12 13 Number 13,963 is reinstated. 14 (Off the record at 9:08 a.m.) 15 (The following proceedings had at 9:33 a.m.) 16 EXAMINER BROOKS: Pursuant to Mr. Kellahin's oral motion, Case Number 13,965 will be dismissed. 17 (Off the record at 9:33 a.m.) 18 19 (The following proceedings had at 2:42 p.m.) 20 EXAMINER BROOKS: Now for the record, before you leave, Mr. Carr, I want to call Case Number -- Let's see 21 where I am here. I want to call for the record Case Number 22 23 13,981 [sic], which is the reopened Application of 24 Petrohawk Energy Corporation for authorization to 25 reactivate a waterflood project, Lea County, New Mexico.

6 May it please the Examiner, William F. 1 MR. CARR: Carr with the Santa Fe office of Holland and Hart. 2 We 3 represent Petrohawk in that matter, and we request that the case be continued to the September 20 Examiner Hearing 4 5 docket. EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, Case Number 13,891 will 6 7 be continued until September the 20th. Thank you.
