EXAMINER JONES: Let's call the first case of the day, Case 13,967, Application of Nearburg Exploration

Company, LLC, for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New

Mexico.

Call for appearances.

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, representing the Applicant. I'm submitting this case by affidavit.

EXAMINER JONES: Any other appearances?

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, in this case Nearburg seeks the pooling of the southwest quarter, southwest quarter of Section 30, 16 South, 39, from the surface to the base of the Drinkard formation. This is for all zones spaced on 40 acres.

Submitted to you as Exhibit Number 1, the only person being pooled is Mr. Kenneth Cone of Midland, Texas, who owns just under 3 percent of the working interest in this lease. Actually, I believe it's an unleased mineral interest. Exhibit 1 is an affidavit from the land manager of Nearburg, and it sets forth the drilling rates, et cetera.

Attached as Exhibit A to this exhibit is a land plat. The well unit is marked, at least on your copy, in

red, the southwest quarter, southwest quarter of Section 30.

Exhibit B is the proposal letter to Mr. Cone, together with the green card showing that he did indeed receive this well proposal in june.

Attached as Exhibit C is the AFE for the well, which has a dryhole cost of about \$831,000, a completed well cost of a little over \$1,500,000.

Submitted as Exhibit 2 is my affidavit of notice. You'll see that Mr. Cone has not yet picked up his certified mail. I was in a hearing, I think, with both you and Mr. Brooks a couple of months ago. This is a common problem with Mr. Cone. You'll see that he did receive the proposal letter, and somebody in his office signed for it, but he has not -- just like a couple of months ago in another case, he has not picked up. But this is an accurate address, and I think I -- in a prior hearing I submitted information to you on this matter.

When I get the green card back, which will probably be in a week or so, I will submit it to the Division.

I believe that notice has been properly given, and we do not need to publish notice at this time.

With that, I would move the admission of Exhibits 1 and 2.
