1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at
2 8:20 a.m.:

3 EXAMINER JONES: Let's call the first case of the
4 day, Case 13,967, Application of Nearburg Exploration
5 Company, LLC, for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New
6 Mexico.

7 Call for appearances.

8 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe,
9 representing the Applicant. I'm submitting this case by
10 affidavit.

11 EXAMINER JONES: Any other appearances?

12 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, in this case Nearburg
13 seeks the pooling of the southwest quarter, southwest
14 quarter of Section 30, 16 South, 39, from the surface to
15 the base of the Drinkard formation. This is for all zones
16 spaced on 40 acres.

17 Submitted to you as Exhibit Number 1, the only
18 person being pooled is Mr. Kenneth Cone of Midland, Texas,
19 who owns just under 3 percent of the working interest in
20 this lease. Actually, I believe it's an unleased mineral
21 interest. Exhibit 1 is an affidavit from the land manager
22 of Nearburg, and it sets forth the drilling rates, et
23 cetera.

24 Attached as Exhibit A to this exhibit is a land
25 plat. The well unit is marked, at least on your copy, in

1 red, the southwest quarter, southwest quarter of Section
2 30.

3 Exhibit B is the proposal letter to Mr. Cone,
4 together with the green card showing that he did indeed
5 receive this well proposal in June.

6 Attached as Exhibit C is the AFE for the well,
7 which has a dryhole cost of about \$831,000, a completed
8 well cost of a little over \$1,500,000.

9 Submitted as Exhibit 2 is my affidavit of notice.
10 You'll see that Mr. Cone has not yet picked up his
11 certified mail. I was in a hearing, I think, with both you
12 and Mr. Brooks a couple of months ago. This is a common
13 problem with Mr. Cone. You'll see that he did receive the
14 proposal letter, and somebody in his office signed for it,
15 but he has not -- just like a couple of months ago in
16 another case, he has not picked up. But this is an
17 accurate address, and I think I -- in a prior hearing I
18 submitted information to you on this matter.

19 When I get the green card back, which will
20 probably be in a week or so, I will submit it to the
21 Division.

22 I believe that notice has been properly given,
23 and we do not need to publish notice at this time.

24 With that, I would move the admission of Exhibits
25 1 and 2.

1 EXAMINER JONES: Exhibits 1 and 2 will be
2 admitted into evidence.

3 Is this a wildcat area?

4 MR. BRUCE: I couldn't find any particular pool.
5 If you look at the land plat there are some wells, but I
6 couldn't find any Drinkard Pool.

7 EXAMINER JONES: Okay. That's their main target,
8 is the Drinkard?

9 MR. BRUCE: Yeah. I mean, there are some wells
10 to the -- it looks like to the east and northeast, but it's
11 a pretty thin area. Over toward the Knowles area there's a
12 lot of Devonian and --

13 EXAMINER JONES: Okay.

14 MR. BRUCE: -- things like that.

15 EXAMINER JONES: Yeah. Okay, thank you. With
16 that, we'll take Case 13,967 under advisement.
