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WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 9:02 a.m.: CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: At this time we'll call to 3 order the Thursday, October 11th, 2007, meeting of the New 4 Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. Let the record reflect 5 that present are Commissioner Bailey and Commissioner 6 Fesmire. Commissioner Olson is not present, however two 7 members of the Commission does make up a quorum. 8 The first issue before the Commission this 9 10 morning is the adoption of the minutes from the September 13th, 2007, meeting. At this time I'll ask Commissioner 11 Bailey if she's had a chance to review the minutes. 12 13 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move we adopt them. 14 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: I'll second that motion. All 15 in favor signify --16 17 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. 18 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Aye. Let the record reflect that the quorum of the 19 20 Commission present adopted the minutes from the September 13th meeting, that the minutes were signed and conveyed to 21 22 the secretary for recording. 23 24 25 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: During this meeting, the

Commission may conduct a closed-door executive session, 1 2 during which it will deliberate in conjunction with administrative adjudicatory proceedings pending before the 3 Commission or consult with the Commission counsel under the 4 attorney-client privilege concerning threatened or pending 5 litigation in which the Commission is or may become a 6 participant. 7 In that vein, Case Number 13,817, the Application 8 of Harvey E. Yates Company for an exemption from Oil 9 Conservation Commission Rule 1915.2.50.A NMAC has been 10 heard by the Commission. An order was issued and the order 1.1 was appealed. 12 Harvey E. Yates Company has approached the 13 14 Division concerning the appeal --15 Should we go into executive session for the -just for the deliberations, or for the presentation of the 16 17 offer? For both. 18 MS. BADA: CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. So at this time the 19 Commission will go into executive session for the sole 20 purpose of hearing a matter concerning Case Number 13,817, 21 the Application of Harvey E. Yates Company. 22 23 (Off the record at 9:04 a.m.) (The following proceedings had at 9:16 a.m.) 24 25 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Let's go back on the record.

Let the record reflect that during the last ten minutes the Commission met in executive session to discuss an offer of the settlement of the appeal in Case Number 13,817, the Application of Harvey E. Yates Company for an exception from Oil Conservation Commission Rule 1915.2.50.A NMAC.

The decision of the Commission was to take no action on the offer of settlement.

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CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next issue before the Commission is Cases Number 13,492 and Case -- consolidated with Case Number 13,493.

13,492 is the Application of Samson Resources
Company, Kaiser-Francis Oil Company and Mewbourne Oil
Company for cancellation of two drilling permits and
approval of a drilling permit in Lea County, New Mexico.

Case Number 13,493 is the Application of Chesapeake Permian, LP, for compulsory pooling in Lea County, New Mexico.

Counsel Bada, would you bring the Commission up to speed on these cases?

MS. BADA: The parties have asked for a continuance of their request for rehearing because they're in settlement negotiations, and they have submitted a

proposed order that would settle the case and that would dismiss the rehearing.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Commissioner Bailey, we have before us an order drafted by Counsel Bada to that effect. Have you had a chance to review that order?

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move that we adopt it.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: I second that motion.

All those in favor signify by saying aye.

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Aye.

Let the record reflect that the motion to sign the order commemorating the agreement between the parties in this case be signed, that it will be signed by the two present members of the Commission and transmitted to the secretary for recording.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: All those in favor -- I second 12 that motion. 13 14 All those in favor signify by saying aye. 15 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Aye. 16 17 Let the record reflect that the two members of 18 the counsel present voted to accept the dismissal and sign the order so dismissing, that the order was signed and 19 20 transmitted to the secretary for recording. 21 22 23 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next case is Case Number 24 13,927, the Application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for a nonstandard gas spacing unit in Eddy County, New Mexico. 25
