STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

JTD Resources, LLC seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Wolfcamp formation underlying the SE/4SW/4 of Section 4, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Undesignated West Nadine-San Andres Pool, West Nadine Paddock-Blinebry Pool, West Nadine-Tubb Pool, and West Nadine-Drinkard Pool. The unit is to be dedicated to the Vinson Well No. 1, located 330 feet from the south line and 2310 feet from the west line of Section 4.
