This letter is to advise you that Petrohawk Energy Corporation (Petrohawk) is seeking approval for a waterflood project, including the reactivation of a previously approved waterflood in Section 8 and 9, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, to inject up to a total of 2000 barrels per day, at a maximum pressure of 750 psi, into the Queen Formation, at an approximate depth of 3790 feet to 3890 feet. This proposed waterflood involves the activation of five existing, temporarily plugged injection wells (State A A/C 2 # 61, #64, #65, #68, #69 and # 71).

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner at 8:15 a.m. on March 15, 2007 at the Oil Conservation Division's Santa Fe office located at 1220 South Saint Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases are required by Division Rule 1208.B to file a Pre-Hearing Statement with the Oil Conservation Division's Santa Fe office four days in advance of a scheduled hearing, but at least on the Thursday preceding the hearing. This statement must include: the names of the parties and their attorneys; a concise statement of the case; the names of all witnesses the party will call to testify at the hearing; the approximate time the party will need to present its case; and identification of any procedural matters that are to be resolved prior to the hearing.


