

1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at
2 8:18 a.m.:

3 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, let's get started this
4 morning. This is the Examiner Hearing for Thursday,
5 September 20th, 2007. I'm William V. Jones. This is David
6 Brooks, and he'll be the Legal Examiner today.

7 This is Docket Number 28-07. Big docket. I hope
8 you guys didn't prepare all night long, and I hope I don't
9 have all the continuances and dismissals, but I'll call
10 them and then ask for corrections here.

11 On page 1, Case 13,984 is dismissed; Case 13,942
12 is continued to October 18th.

13 None on page 2.

14 And on page 3, Case 13,991 on the bottom of page
15 3 is continued to October 18th.

16 On page 4, first two cases, Case 13,897 is
17 continued to the 18th of October; Case 13,891 continued to
18 the 18th of October.

19 And on -- Let's see here, on page 7. On page 7
20 the top two cases there, Case 13,972 and Case 13,973, we
21 haven't cleared this with the court reporter yet, but we
22 wanted to continue these till a special hearing docket on
23 October the 12th, which is a Friday.

24 And then on the bottom of that page, Case 13,957
25 continued to October the 3rd.
