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## **APPLICATION**

Harvey E. Yates Company applies for an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying Lots 1, 2, E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, and NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> (the N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>) of Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is an interest owner in the  $N\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 18, and has the right to drill a well thereon.

2. Applicant proposes to drill the Walker 18 Fed. Com. Well No. 1, at an orthodox location in Lot 2 of Section 18, to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation, and seeks to dedicate the following acreage to the well:

(a) Lots 1, 2, and  $E\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{4}$  (the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section 18 to form a standard 161.89 acre gas and spacing and proration unit for all pools or formations developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent; and

(b) The  $N\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 18 to the well to form a standard 321.89 acre gas and spacing and proration unit for all pools or formations developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Northwest Young-Morrow Gas Pool.

3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the  $N\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 18 for the purposes set forth herein.

4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of Section 18, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interests underlying the N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of Section 18 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

A. Pooling all mineral interests in the  $N\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 18, from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation;

B. Designating applicant as operator of the well;

C. Considering the cost of re-entering and completing the well, and allocating the cost among the well's working interest owners;

D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and

E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in re-entering and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.
