MUNDS-DRY: Mr. Examiner, Ocean Munds-Dry 12 13

MS. MUNDS-DRY: Mr. Examiner, Ocean Munds-Dry with Holland and Hart, representing Yates Petroleum Corporation. It's our understanding that Edge and Yates are talking and reaching agreement, and we're just entering our appearance in this case.

EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay.

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MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, this case was presented, but it was continued in order to get the affidavit of publication, which is submitted as Exhibit 7.

And two other matters.

Exhibit 6 is the affidavit of notice which was submitted at the last go-around. There was one interest owner who had not yet returned or -- signed or returned his green card. And I'm not numbering this, but Kenneth Cone

You had asked at the hearing -- Coates Energy 7 Trust and some related trusts were being force pooled, and 8 you asked the name of the current trust --EXAMINER BROOKS: Right. 9 MR. BRUCE: -- which did not appear of record. 10 11 Those trustees are Barry Coates, which is C-o-a-t-e-s, Roberts and George L. Stieren, S-t-i-e-r-e-n. They are the 12 13 trustees of all of the trusts who were force pooled -- who are being force pooled. 14 However -- and I will let the Division know when 15 it was received. Those parties have agreed to lease, the 16 17 Coates trusts have agreed to lease. 18 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay. 19 MR. BRUCE: As Ms. Munds-Dry has said, Yates 20 Petroleum and Edge are also negotiating, and if an 21 agreement is reached I will notify the Division regarding 22 the same. 23 Okay. Anything further?
