STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from 7000 feet subsurface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the W/2 of Section 28, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all pools or formations developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the proposed Paloma "28" Fed. Com. Well No. 1, to be drilled at an orthodox location in the SW/4NW/4 of Section 28. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
