WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 8:48 a.m.: EXAMINER EZEANYIM: And now we call Case Number 3 This is the Application of Parallel Petroleum 4 5 Corporation for compulsory pooling, Chaves County, New 6 Mexico. 7 Call for appearances. MR. KELLAHIN: Mr. Examiner, I'm Tom Kellahin of 8 the Santa Fe law firm of Kellahin and Kellahin, appearing 9 this morning on behalf of the Applicant. Again, we're 10 requesting your permission to submit this case by 11 affidavit. 12 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: You have no witnesses? 13 14 MR. KELLAHIN: No, sir. EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Any other appearances, 15 16 please? 17 Okay, you can proceed. 18 MR. KELLAHIN: The basis for submitting this by affidavit, Mr. Examiner, is that Parallel on prior 19 20 occasions has dealt with what I used to know as the Highway Department -- it's now the New Mexico Department of 21 22 Transportation -- and as we've seen before you on prior 23 occasions, they have an interest in the minerals with 24 regards to surface easements the Highway Department had 25 obtained historically for use of the surface.

Unfortunately, however that was done, they also ended up with a fractional share of the minerals. There is no procedure in place at the Department of Transportation where they feel they have the rules or the authority to execute a voluntary lease.

So the custom and practice before the Division is to pool the agency's interest in those odd little tracts so we can complete the 100-percent commitment of the properties to the wells, and that's the situation here.

And we've attached to the affidavit by Mr. Myers his letter contacts. They started back in May of this year with the Highway Department, Department of Transportation. He's had conversations with those people. We always get to the same point, they say they have no authority and they decline to do anything further.

We've sent them notice of the hearing today which indicates that they received the notice.

Attached is the AFE and the plats with regard to drilling the well.

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Do you have the affidavit with you?

MR. KELLAHIN: I'm sorry.

The documents are all stapled together as a single presentation, although Exhibit 1 contains the affidavit and the attachments. And then as you continue

through the package of stapled documents, Exhibit Number 2 1 2 is my certificate of notice to the Department of 3 Transportation. Mr. Myers attests to the accuracy of the AFE. 4 He's saying it's current and reasonable. There's a plat 5 showing the well location and how it's to be drilled. 6 7 plat has been approved by the Division. Then we have their permit, an API number issued, and they're ready to proceed 8 with the drilling of the well. 9 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: What API Number? Is the API 10 number here? 11 MR. KELLAHIN: I'm looking. 12 It's here, oh, never mind. EXAMINER EZEANYIM: 13 Yeah, it's here, don't worry about it. 14 15 EXAMINER BROOKS: Department of Transportation is 16 the only non-adjoining party? 17 MR. KELLAHIN: Yes, sir. EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Did you say that it was in 18 the APD? 19 MR. KELLAHIN: Yes, the docket shows that there's 20 21 an approved API number. 22 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Yeah. Go ahead. 23 MR. KELLAHIN: That's all I have, Mr. Examiner. We would move the introduction of Exhibits 1 and 24 25 2.
