- 1 EXAMINER JONES: If we can go back on the record this
- 2 morning and call Case No. 14089, application of Mewbourne Oil
- 3 Company for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Call
- 4 for appearances.
- 5 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe
- 6 representing the applicant, Mewbourne Oil Company. I'm
- 7 submitting this case by affidavit, Mr. Examiner. In this case,
- 8 Mewbourne Oil Company seeks to pool the south half of Section
- 9 2, 17S, 29E from the top of the Wolfcamp to the base of the
- 10 Morrow formation.
- There is only one interest owner being pooled whose
- 12 been identified in the first page of Exhibit 1. This interest
- 13 owner is un-locatable. There is a proposal letter that was
- 14 sent to Mr. Charles Harlon, Jr. It was rumored the affidavit
- 15 does speak of the efforts to locate Mr. Harlon. He apparently
- 16 required his interests about 30, 35 years ago and disappeared.
- 17 As a result, publication against him was made in the
- 18 Carlsbad newspaper and that affidavit of publication is
- 19 submitted as Exhibit 2. Exhibit 1 contains the well location
- 20 plat and AFE for the well, and I think it complies with the
- 21 rule. So I simply ask that Exhibit 1 and 2 be admitted into
- 22 evidence and this matter be taken into advisement.
- 23 EXAMINER JONES: Exhibit 1 and 2 will be admitted in
- 24 this case and Case No. 14089 will be taken under advisement.
