Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that McElvain Oil & Gas Properties, Inc. has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order compulsory pooling all mineral interests in the Mesa Verde formation in certain spacing and proration units located in the E/2 of Section 14, Township 25 North, Range 2 West, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Said pooled units are to be dedicated to the following two wells: the Badger Com 14-2 well and the Badger Com 14-2A well, which will be drilled to test the Mesa Verde formation, Blanco Mesa Verde Gas Pool. The Badger Com 14-2 well will be drilled as a wildcat well from a standard location 671 feet from the North line and 1530 feet from the East line in the NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 14 to test the Mesa Verde formation at a depth of approximately 5,898 feet. The Badger Com 14-2A well will be drilled as a wildcat well from a standard location 663 feet from the South line and 965 feet from the East line in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 14 to test the Mesa Verde formation at a depth of approximately 5,850 feet. This statement must include: the names of the parties and their attorneys; a concise statement of the case; the names of all witnesses the party will call to testify at the hearing; the approximate time the party will need to present its case; and identification of any procedural matters that are to be resolved prior to the hearing.


