1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at  
2 8:18 a.m.:

3 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, let's get started this  
4 morning. This is -- it may be a -- kind of a long day.  
5 This is Docket Number 34-07, the Examiner Hearing. I'm  
6 William V. Jones. This is Thursday, November the 1st,  
7 2007.

8 Let's first call the continuances and dismissals.

9 On the first page, Case 13,980 is continued to  
10 January the 10th; Case 14,014 is continued to January the  
11 10th.

12 Page 2, all cases on that page are continued to  
13 November 29th. That's Cases 13,990, Case 14,016, Case  
14 14,017, Case 14,018, all continued to November 29th.

15 On page 3 -- page 3, we'll hear those cases.

16 Page 4, Case 13,960 is continued to November  
17 29th; Case 13,981 is continued to November 29th.

18 And on page 5, Case 13,897 on the bottom of the  
19 page is dismissed.

20 And on page 6, Case 13,940 is continued to  
21 November 29th.

22 As you notice, we don't have a hearing in the  
23 middle of November this month, so next hearing will be  
24 November 29th.
