Please submit the appropriate revision to include these wells in the Mesaverde participating area.

The Rincon Unit Well No.11E is a non-commercial well in the Mesaverde formation but will be included in the PA because the Well No. 11P (S/2 Sec. 6-26N-6W) qualifies as a commercial well.
