19 drilling permit, for determination of the right to drill
20 and approval of a drilling permit, Lea County, New Mexico.

21 By the acquiescence of counsel, this case will be
22 dismissed. But we have no order at this time; is that
23 correct? Oh, there is one? Oh, okay.

24 This is in conjunction with Case Number 13,912,
25 the Application of EOG Resources, Inc., for a compulsory

1 pooling in Lea County, New Mexico.

2 Counsel for these two cases, these related cases,
3 has asked that both cases be dismissed. The secretary has
4 drafted an order to that effect.

5 Commissioners, have you had a chance to review
6 the order?

7 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move we
8 adopt it.

9 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Commissioner Olson?

10 COMMISSIONER OLSON: Second.

5 9:50 a.m.)

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
