Page 3 1 MR. BROOKS: The next case on the docket is Case 2 No. 14110. The Division indicated that they have a witness who 3 is not here yet. Is that correct, Ms. MacQuesten? 4 MS. MACQUESTEN: That's right, Mr. Examiner. MR. BROOKS: We have a number of uncontested matters 5 on the outside docket, so I believe we will go ahead with 6 7 those, pending the arrival of the missing witness. 8 At this time, we'll call Case No. 14085, the Application of Cimarex Energy Company for a non-standard oil 9 spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea County, 10 New Mexico. 11 12 Call for appearances. 13 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe. I 14 have no witnesses. MR. CARR: May it please The Examiner, my name is 15 William F. Carr with the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart, 16 LLP. We are entering our appearance in this case for 17 18 Occidental Permian Limited Partnership. I have no witnesses. MR. BROOKS: Mr. Bruce, you may proceed. 19 20 Well, before you do, has this case been heard 21 previously? Is this a follow-up? MR. BRUCE: That is correct, Mr. Examiner. 22 I'11 23 explain that. 24 Mr. Examiner, this case was presented. It's a horizontal well being drilled over on Township 15 South, 25

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Page 4 1 37 East in Lea County to test the Wolfcamp formation. It was 2 presented, I think, about six weeks ago. And in these cases, 3 the Division has made the applicant notify -- the pooling portion of the case was presented. And in these cases, the 4 5 Division has required the applicant to notify offset operators. 6 And at the hearing, it turned out that there was -- I needed to 7 check on additional offset operators. 8 MR. BROOKS: Yes. MR. BRUCE: And the subject well is in the west half 9 of the southwest quarter of Section 13, 15 South, 37 East. 10 At 11 the original hearing, affidavits from the landman and the geologist were submitted, and evidence was presented as to 12 notice to the offset operator to the west and to the south. 13 14The operator to the west was Lynx Operating Company 15 Inc. MR. BROOKS: Now, do you have a map here where I can 16 refresh my recollection on these matters? 17 18 MR. BRUCE: Let me give you the original Exhibit 1 in 19 that matter, Mr. Examiner. MR. BROOKS: I probably have a copy in here, but I 20 don't know --21 22 MR. BRUCE: Here's the plat attached to the landman's 23 exhibit. The locations are in the southwest quarter. The 24 operator to the immediate west is Lynx Operating Company Inc., 25 and they have been notified. The operators to the north, east

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Page 5 and south -- Cimarex is the only operator, Cimarex Energy 1 Company, who, of course, did not need to be notified. 2 And then if you'll look to the southwest in the --3 what is it? The east half of Section 23? 4 5 MR. BROOKS: Yeah, Section 23. 6 MR. BRUCE: You'll see that there is a single tract covering the east half of the section. I thought that had been 7 8 under farmout to Cimarex. It partially is, but after getting together with the landman, I determined that there were 9 10 additional working interest owners who needed to be notified. And the purpose of this case is to present notice to the offset 11 12 operators. 13 MR. BROOKS: Okay. 14 MR. BRUCE: Submitted to you is Exhibit 5. 15 Exhibits 1 through 4 were presented at the original hearing. 16 The Exhibit 5 is the affidavit of the landman who works for 17 Shaw Interests, Inc., which is a contract land outfit who works 18 for Cimarex. 19 And attached to that exhibit is a listing of mineral interest owners. And it is a fully-leased tract. And if you 20 21 look at Pages 4 and 5 of the attachment, you'll see a listing of lessees in this tract. Now, many of those are under farmout 22 23 to Cimarex, but I went ahead and notified all of them anyway. 24 MR. BROOKS: Okay. 25 MR. BRUCE: Exhibit 6 is the affidavit of mailing to
