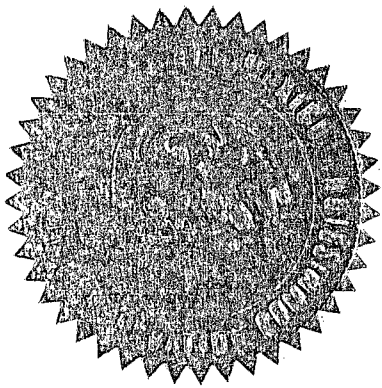
BY THE DIVISION:

This matter came on for decision before the Director of the Oil Conservation Division on May 9, 2008, upon the verbal request of the Supervisor of District II.

Now, on this 9 day of May, 2008, the Division Director, having considered the request, and the records and other information provided by the Supervisor of District II,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) The Division has jurisdiction over this case and its subject matter.
- (2) Mesquite SWD, Inc. ("Mesquite"), OGRID 161968, is the operator of record of the Exxon State No. 008, API No. 30-015-22055, located in Unit letter O, Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 27 East in Eddy County, New Mexico.
- (3) On December 31, 1976, the Oil Conservation Commission issued Order No. SWD-180, which authorized the Exxon State No. 008 well to inject into the "Yates formation at approximately 570 feet to approximately 600 feet."
